



RESIN JOURNAL ART KIT

Supply List

Silicone journal cover molds	Transparent butterflies	Binder rings
Resin & Hardener	Dried flowers	Spray alcohol
Glitter	Loose lavender flowers	Mixing cups
	Gold leaf	Mixing stick
	Tweezers	Apron & gloves

INSTRUCTIONS

Work surface must be level. Temperature should be 65 degrees Fahrenheit or above. You will need a measuring spoon.

- Prepare molds:
Front of journal rings on the left.<-
Back of journal rings on the right->.



Instructions are for doing BOTH covers at the same time.

- To help with pouring and reduce cloudiness, place resin & hardener bottles in a zipped bag in hot water for 10-15 minutes prior to mixing.
NEVER WARM RESIN IN MICROWAVE OR ON STOVE TOP!
- Meanwhile, gently position the dried flowers and butterflies inside both molds. Take a picture, then remove only the butterflies.
- Add 6TBS each of resin and hardener. Stir vigorously for 3.5 minutes. Clean spoon immediately!
- Separate resin as desired (clear, with glitter and/or with color) as desired.
- Using the plain clear resin, pour around the edges and over the flower arrangement. Add butterflies as desired (refer to your picture).
- Add colors and gold leaf as desired.
- Spritz surfaces with alcohol to release bubbles – 2-3 pumps should do it.
- Let resin cure 24-48 hours before demolding.
- Once covers are fully cured, add binder rings and paper for a beautiful journal you can keep or gift as a treasure forever.
