



ACRYLIC POUR ON CERAMIC TILES

Supply List

8 Ceramic tiles	Vial of silicone	Color Matrix
6 Paints premixed w/pouring medium	Pipette	Mixing Cups
	Tile stands	Stir sticks
	Cork adhesives	Apron and gloves

INSTRUCTIONS

- Prep surface with covering.
- Put on apron & gloves.
- Tighten paint lids, then shake vigorously.
- Remove any packing wax on tiles & clean surface thoroughly.
- Elevate tiles above the surface using tile stands. This allows for paint drainage.
- Using Color Matrix, cups and stir sticks and paints to create your own color palette by blending colors as you like.
- **TIP:** Add 2-3 drops of silicone in colors if you'd like to get paint pouring "cells".



HOW MANY TILES TO POUR AT ONE TIME?

We recommend doing 1 set of 4 tiles, and 4 individual tiles, or you can create whatever you arrangements you prefer.

POURING OPTIONS

There are many methods and techniques for paint pouring. We will introduce you to a couple of them.

FLIP CUP – RECOMMENDED FOR ONE TILE ONLY

- Gently pour paints into one of the smaller cups, one at a time, layering each one on top of the other until the cup is filled.
- Place tile on top of cup, with the shiny side facing down. Hold together, then flip over and set back on tile stand. Allow paint to settle, then lift away cup at an angle. Proceed to section FINISH IT UP.

TREE RING POUR - FOR 1 TILE OR A SET OF 4 TILES

- Elevate tile(s) and if doing a set, arrange tiles so that there is no space between them (don't lose paint in gaps!)
- Gently pour paints into one of the larger cups, one at a time, layering each one on top of the other until the cup is filled.
- At approximately 8-12 inches above the tile, gently pour paint into the center of the tile(s) using a slight circular motion, like pancakes. Go slow!!!
- Once your paint is on the surface, allow a minute for the paint to spread.

FINISH IT UP

- Lift each tile from the sides. Tilt slowly, in a circular motion.
- It is expected to tilt off some of the paint, BUT NOT ALL.
- Continue doing this until you like the way it looks. It is best to do one circular rotation. Do not over-tilt.
- Return the tile to its original stand, leaving a gap between the tiles for drainage.
- Allow to fully dry for a day or two (or longer in humid or cold climates).
- Apply cork to bottom of each tile, then display proudly.

TIP: If using as coasters, we recommend applying a protective top coat.
